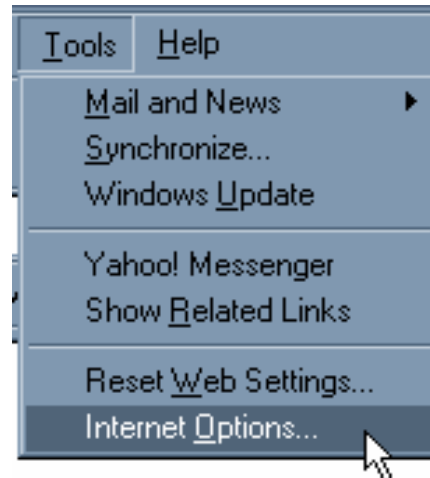




Internet Explorer can remember common entries – like your name, street address, email address, phone number, etc – so you do not have to retype them every time you fill out a form online.

In addition, Explorer can save you time retyping long web site names, by automatically completing them from past entries as you type.

Finally, AutoComplete can store your username and passwords for secure web sites, so you don't have to retype them every time you access private data online.



Click TOOLS

Click INTERNET OPTIONS

On the CONTENT TAB, click AUTOCOMPLETE

Check off the items you wish.

NOTE: If you share your computer with another person, DO NOT SAVE passwords – otherwise, they will be able to access your secure sites. If you plan to give your computer to another user, return to this menu and click CLEAR FORMS and CLEAR PASSWORDS to reset all lists and delete all passwords.
