



The FAVORITES tool will keep a list of personal sites you wish to visit frequently without having to retype or remember their URL address. Favorites are like “bookmarks” on the internet.

**From any web site,  
Click FAVORITES...  
ADD TO FAVORITES**

To return to your favorites in the future, click FAVORITES and scroll up/down the list to find the site you wish to revisit.

A special function of FAVORITES is the ability to “capture” a web site and store it offline on your computer. This can be useful for viewing the site when you are not connected to the internet (laptop users) or if your connection is slow (you can setup the capture to occur while you are away). It is also a great way to have a web site on your laptop for a presentation, without having to actually connect to the internet!

**Click FAVORITES... ADD to favorites  
Check off MAKE AVAILABLE OFFLINE  
Click CUSTOMIZE**

**Follow the Wizard to setup the parameters for the capture:**

**DOWNLOAD at least 2 links deep for most sites – since you need to go beyond the main menu in most cases – but NOT TOO DEEP or you will use lots of storage space!**

**Setup a SCHEDULE and Explorer will capture (and refresh) the web site data every day at a certain time – perfect for refreshing in the morning before you disconnect your laptop from the web and hit the road!**

**To access a “captured” web site offline, launch explorer and just find the site in your FAVORITES LIST. It will look just like you are online!**
